ALL ROADS LEAD TO KILLALOE

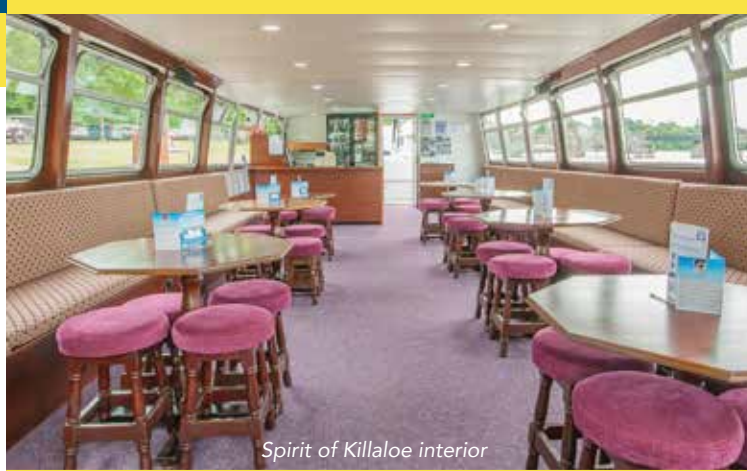

We sail everyday from **March 1st to November 1st**. Our full up to date schedule is available on our website when you click on **"Book Now"**.

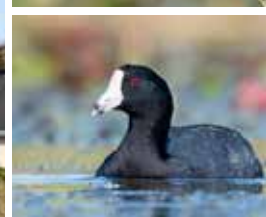
We depart from Ballina Quay which is located on Lakeside Drive in the town of Ballina County Tipperary.

Directly across the bridge is the town of Killaloe in County Clare. Free parking is available in both towns.

Killaloe and Ballina are a popular visitor location and heavy traffic is to be expected. Please allow enough time to reach our location.

It is necessary to arrive for your cruise 10 minutes before departure time.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Take a cruise along the River Shannon and Lough Derg with Killaloe River Cruises.
- Follow the footsteps of Brian Boru, the High King of Ireland from 1002-1014 along the Killaloe Heritage Trail. (Green dotted route follow the green signposts on the map).
- Looking for the best variety of food in Ireland's Hidden Heartlands? From coffee to artisanal eats, these foodie delights are all available in Killaloe and Ballina.
- A walk for the very active is the Ballycuggaran Loop. There are spectacular views of Lough Derg along this route also. (Red dotted route follow the red arrows along the walk on the map).
- Enjoy a picnic on the banks of the River Shannon.
- Take the short drive to Tuamgraney and visit McKernan Woollen Mills and Wildes Irish Chocolates.
- Drive to O'Brien's Bridge and take the 20-minute walk along the river bank to the weir built in 1929 as part of the Shannon Hydro Electric Scheme.
- If you are feeling adventurous drive to the Graves of the Leinstermen and take the 30-minute walk each way to the Millenium cross. (Blue dotted route on the map).
- Enjoy live music in one of the many locations.
- Visit St. Flannan's Cathedral.
- Enjoy a swim at the Blue Flag bathing area at twomilegate Killaloe.
- Indulge yourself with afternoon tea available in both hotels.
- Explore one of Ireland's newest Blueway's by canoe.
- Fun for kids at one of the playgrounds located at Killaloe, Ballina and Castlelough.
- Swim at the outdoor heated pool in the Ballina Riverside Park open June - August.
- Indoor activities available at the National Karting Centre, Kidstown and The Sports Factory (Larkins Cross).
